Students' attendance from first to final year is uploaded on 29.11.2024.

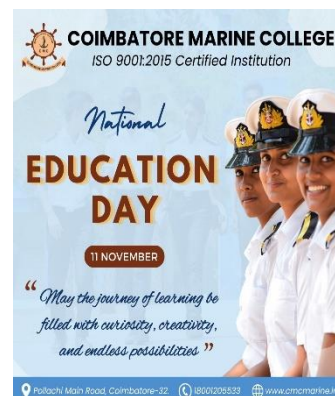
WEBINAR ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP
